

# FIRE, EXPLOSION OR DANGEROUS GOODS SPILL

<b>Definition</b>	<p>Any fire, including the generation of heat or smoke without visible flames; or explosion, including an implosion; or loss of containment of dangerous goods associated with or impacting railway operations.</p>	
<b>CAT A</b> Immediate	<p>A fire, explosion or dangerous goods spill that directly threatens the safety of people.</p>	<b>CAT C</b> Annual
<b>CAT B</b> 72hrs	<p>A fire, explosion or dangerous goods spill that does not threaten the safety of people, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a fire on an unoccupied locomotive or in an unoccupied driving cab;</li> <li>• a lineside fire that has been started by a train;</li> <li>• a fire that resulted in damage to infrastructure or rolling stock.</li> </ul> <p>Any dangerous goods spill event that resulted in damage to infrastructure or rolling stock.</p>	<b>Not Reportable to ONRSR</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lineside fires not caused by or impacting railway operations.</li> <li>• Minor fuel spills from refrigerated containers and wagons.</li> <li>• Minor fires caused by vandalism that self-extinguished and did not cause significant damage.</li> <li>• Dangerous goods spill that did not result in damage or threaten the safety of people.</li> </ul>
