| CAT A Immediate | <p>Any rail safety incident (not elsewhere reportable as a Category A) directly threatening safety of people or railway operations.</p> <p>Some examples may include, but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sabotage or cyber security event that threatened the safety of people or railway operations; or • an event resulting in an emergency evacuation to protect public safety; or • sudden incapacity of a rail safety worker performing safety critical task or function; or • detraining of passengers into an uncontrolled environment; or • trains significantly exceeding the permitted speed limit. • Incidents occurring in worksites that had the potential to cause serious injuries or death. | CAT C Annual <p>All Incident directly threatening safety is a Category A</p> |
